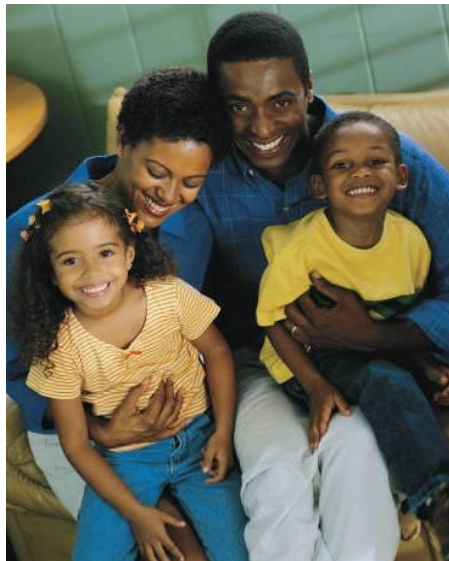


OUR MISSION

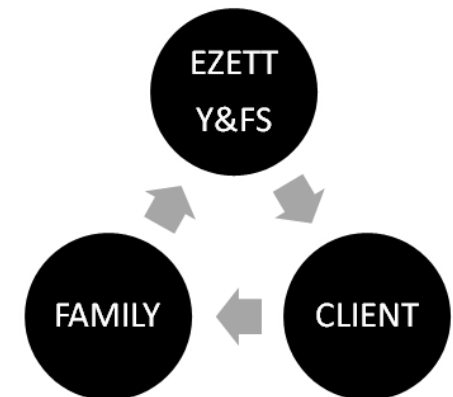

INTENSIVE IN-HOME COUNSELING (IHC) SERVICE DESCRIPTION

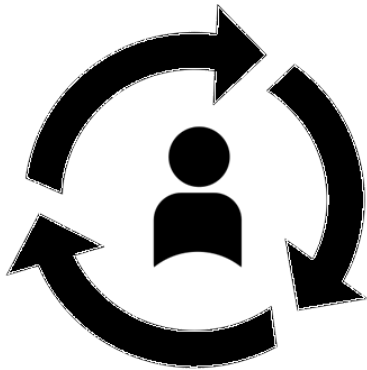
Intensive In-home Counseling Service is a short term, client centered, family oriented behavior intervention program. In-home serves children and adolescents, ages four to twenty-one, who have been diagnosed with mental, behavioral, and or emotional disorders, and are currently facing challenges that impede their functioning at home, school, and or in the community. In-home also serves those children and adolescents who have been in the custody of Social Services or the Department of Juvenile Justice system and are returning back to their homes and communities. Interventions are designed and structured treatment modalities that include the youth, family members, school personnel, other providers, and community service agencies.

MENTAL HEALTH SKILL-BUILDING (MHSS) DESCRIPTION

Mental Health Skill Building Service is a goal directed, client centered Service, which provides education, skill building, case management, service coordination, and training for adults who are diagnosed with serious mental illnesses to include dual diagnosis, resulting in significant functional impairments to major life activities.

ACCEPTS MEDICAID

III ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ❖ Individual must be between the age of four and twenty-one at time of referral.
- ❖ Individual must have a mental health diagnosis.
- ❖ Individual must present a risk of out of home placement and or hospitalization due to behavioral difficulties, emotional/mental health difficulties, abuse, neglect, or judiciary intervention.
- ❖ Individual is living at home or returning home from a residential facility, foster care, or correctional facility and need to be successfully transitioned into the home.
- ❖ Individual is having difficulties with establishing or maintaining normal interpersonal relationships to such a degree that they are at-risk of hospitalization and or removal from place of residence.
- ❖ Individual and at least one adult guardian are willing to participate in the service.

MHSS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ❖ Individual must be 18 years or older.
- ❖ Individual must have a serious mental illness and or dual diagnosis of mental health and substance abuse which have resulted in significant impairment to daily activities.
- ❖ Individual reentering the community from residential placement or psychiatric hospitalization.
- ❖ Individuals whose welfare has been abused and or is threatened.
- ❖ Individuals whose mental, behavioral or emotional condition is such that it creates a major impairment in their ability to function in the home and or community.
